

# 2020 OASSA/Cheer Ohio Private Camps: Camp Rules & Terms of Agreement

## **FACILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

- Football field and/or gymnasium.
- You must supply your own mats.
- Need access to restrooms.
- Coaches/Parents are to provide lunches and water for the campers.
- You must provide a copy of the facility approval form from your AD prior to your camp.
- NO outside visitors are permitted (family, friends, etc.)
