Spectator Admission: 1 time entry fee
\$5 for adults; \$3 for students

Concessions: Available for purchase beginning at 8:00 a.m.

Parking: Spectators are asked to park in front of the school buildings in any lot besides the bus lot closest to the 795 and Lemoyne Rd. Spectator entrance will be the main entrance of the High School.

Bus Parking: Lot closest to 795 and Lemoyne Rd. intersection. See attached ariel map for bus parking.

Team Drop-off: Buses should drop off athletes prior to parking. Drop off should take place in front of the flag poles between the Middle School and High Schools. All teams and coaches should enter through the breeze way located behind the flag poles for check-in.

Rules

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- All current NFHS and AACCA (USASF for All Star) Rules will be followed.
- There will be three routine judges.
- All participants must have a signed medical/liability form at the competition.
- All members of the squads must be current members of the official school spirit squad and must attend the school they are representing.
- 1st, 2nd & 3rd place trophies will be awarded in each category/division.

TIME LIMITATIONS:

- Cheer routines may not exceed 2 minutes and 30 seconds.
- The music portion must not exceed 1 minute and 30 seconds (School Teams)
- Timing will begin with the first movement or when the music begins.
- If performing an exhibition the routine may not exceed 5 minutes with any amount of the time being music.

COMPETITION AREA:

- The cheer competition area will be 9 standard cheer mats which is 42 X 54 feet.
- Signs or props may be used.
- There will be no deduction for stepping off of the mat (However the use of an alternate to assist in handing out props is not allowed).

JUDGING:

- The judges will score using the score sheet attached
- All decisions by the judges will be final. Score sheets may be reviewed for clarification only.

PROCEDURE FOR QUESTIONING:

- Questions concerning performance should be made immediately after the performance by the coach of the team.
- Questions are to be directed to the Competition Directors.

SPORTSMANSHIP:

- All participants agree to conduct themselves in a manner displaying good sportsmanship at all times during the competition.
- The team's coach will be held responsible for conduct of their team and parents.
- Serious infractions of sportsmanship will result in disqualification, and/or removal from the gym.
- Infractions are under the discretion of the Competition Directors
