BAM Program participants build confidence and capacity in the areas that matter most—from instructional leadership and team building to communication, time management, and using data to drive student success.

Program Details:

- One year of mentoring with nationally trained OAESA/OASSA mentors;
- Paid registration to the OAESA/OASSA Beginning Administrators Academy (BAA) professional development events in September and December;
- OAESA/OASSA BAM Mentee Services, including:
 - a webinar series focused on HQIM, literacy and mathematics achievement, and Ohio's Integrated MTSS framework;
 - weekly communications with curated resources, tools, and leadership guidance aligned to Ohio's priorities;
 - ongoing networking and collaboration opportunities with peers;
 - access to association publications, including magazines and newsletters;
- Access to a 360° feedback tool with coaching support for the OPES 2.0 evaluation process;
- An in-person mentor/mentee convening to facilitate collaboration and connection.
